- Legal background and expansion of Canada's Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) laws.
- Details various cases of euthanasia-related abuses where individuals have been mistreated by MAiD laws.

- Oregon: poor safeguarding in Physician-Assisted Suicide model.
- New South Wales, Australia: reduction in palliative care fund when Voluntary Assisted Dying (VAD) introduced.
- Belgium and Netherlands: level of unreported assisted deaths (1 in 2, and 1 in 5 respectively).
- Denmark: Danish Ethics Council judges euthanasia to be in conflict with palliative care.

Third guest speaker: Dr Gillian Wright

- Medical community's fears of an assisted dying law, particularly palliative care doctors.
- Under-provision of palliative care doctors.

Fourth guest speaker: Gordon Macdonald

- Trajectory of the proposed Assisted Dying Bill in Scotland.
- Discusses inclusions such as at-home consultation and absence of ones such as prior psychiatric/palliative treatments.

Fifth guest speaker: Dr Rachel Ruddy

• Shares developments in Jersey and the public backlash to proposed assisted dying laws.

Sixth guest speaker: Dr Graham McCall

- Gave updates on the Isle of Man's Assisted Dying Bill 2023.
- Outlined doctors' backlash on the Island.
